The tuition fee covers expenses for the retreat, classes, speakers, breaks, meals, notebooks, materials, transportation and the graduation program. The fee may be paid by the participant, the participant's sponsor or by scholarship assistance granted solely on the basis of need. The program requires a serious commitment of time; therefore, participants who miss more than two sessions will be asked to withdraw from the program. In this case, no portion of the tuition will be refunded.

Selection of Participants

Up to fifteen participants will be selected through an application process, which is conducted by the program's selection committee.

Leadership potential, community involvement, past accomplishments and recommendations are among the criteria used in the selection process. The committee is responsible for assuring that Leadership Clinton-Sampson participants reflect the community's diversity.

Participants must prepare for each session by completing any assignments given by the session moderator.
